Wales - Overview



- Micro businesses & SME's dominate the market – over 99%
- Manufacturing is a large contributor to the Welsh economy, more than other areas of the UK
- Close links between Industry, Government and Academia
- Strong Academic presence; 8 Universities across Wales



Wales - Connectivity

- Main business connected via the M4 corridor
- A travel time of under 2 hours Cardiff to London
- Sea ports handling 54m tonnes or 10% of the UK's sea-freight
- Cardiff International Airport









Welsh Economic Benchmarks

- 82.3% of Welsh businesses expect their turnover to stay the same or increase in the next 12 months
- 72.4% expect their profitability to remain the same or increase in the same period
- 91.9% of Welsh businesses see new domestic and international markets as an opportunity for recovery
